Specifically, we provide crisis, evacuation and personnel recovery planning that prepares companies and their employees to operate safely in high-risk areas.

Our packages can include:

- *Tailored and specific emergency action plans for a specific location, country or region (pre-planning for permissive, semi-permissive, non-permissive recovery).*
- *Scheduled situation reports and updates (from multi-source commercial intelligence and local vetted partners).*
- *Training for corporate leadership in decision-making for the specific location and employee-focused training for high-risk locations (includes rehearsals at home and abroad [location permitting]).*
- *Equipment for day-to-day communications and personal security devices with associated training (encrypted mobile phones, GSM/Satellite locator beacons, satellite phones and satellite WiFi).*
- *Sourcing of equipment for worst-case personnel movement (aircraft, boats, ground vehicles, operations center, security elements, host-nation liaison, other specialized equipment).*
- *Operations support (main operations center, mobile operations center, integrated communications with mobile units and recovery elements, highly experienced former Joint Personnel Recovery Center operators and staff).*

Evacuation-Personnel Recovery Plans

- Current situation report and background - information derived through social media tracking, commercial intelligence, in-country teams, open-source fusion, imagery, local contacts in business and government.
- Ground analysis and assessment.
- Permissive, Semi-permissive, Non-permissive evacuation/recovery options.
- Best method for extraction.
- Airfield and Surface route surveys.
- Vetting of local personnel that may be required to support the evacuation.
- Identification of drop zones and infiltration.
- Passenger management.
- Airborne systems and active information gathering systems for situational awareness.
- Specialists, experts, instructors, Pilots, Drivers, Ship handlers, Operators, Medics,
- Military/Law Enforcement/Information Collection
- Language capability - Arabic, Asian, European, Russian, some African languages.

Executing the Plan - Operations Support

- Current situation reports updated on a scheduled/unscheduled basis.
- Operational implementation and coordination with host nation government, industry and ITAR-compliance.
- Visa processing, administrative support for personnel movement.
- Establish airfield and landing zone C2, as required.
- Provide a ground liaison element, as required.
- Evaluate health of evacuees and provide medical support and medical evacuation, as required.
- Cooperation with indigenous security forces, as required.
- Identifying good business partners in host nations that can support the movement.
- Military and government liaison elements, as required.
- Improvised Landing Zone (ILZ) experts to build immediate action airfields, as required.
- Client has direct access to Operational Commander.
- Depending on budget: Trident can provide sophisticated ground/airborne sensing and communications to support the evacuation/recovery.

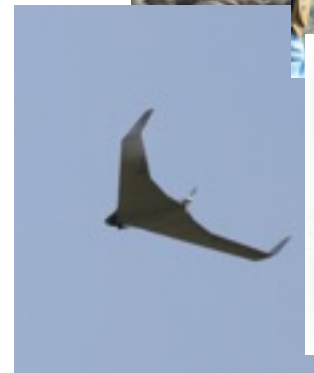
