This plan will include current intelligence, training for corporate leadership in decision-making for the specific location and employees working in high-risk locations, equipment resources for day-to-day communications and personal security (encrypted mobile phones, locator beacons, satellite phones and satellite WiFi), sourcing of equipment for worst-case personnel movement (aircraft, boats, ground vehicles, operations center, security elements, host-nation liaison), operations support.
